## Citizen Checklist - Election 2008

[REGISTER](#) to vote by October 6th 2008

[VERIFY](#) your registration. Even if you have registered before!

EDUCATE yourself about the issues  
(link to issues coming soon!)

[DECIDE](#) how you are going to vote before you get to the polls

[VERIFY YOUR POLLING LOCATION](#) if you have moved or are unsure of where to go

[VOTE EARLY](#) to avoid long lines by absentee ballot or by going to your local [Board of Elections](#)

TAKE YOUR IDENTIFICATION to the polls

ASK FOR A PAPER BALLOT if the lines are long and you cannot wait

ASK FOR A PROVISIONAL BALLOT if you have a problem voting

Election Day is November 4th 2008
