MDN RELEASES PRESIDENTIAL CANDIDATES' FINAL RESPONSES TO POLITICAL REFORM QUESTIONNAIRE

CHICAGO - Since mid-February, the country has witnessed a heated debate about which presidential candidates are or are not committed to forgoing private financing of their general election campaigns this fall in favor of participating in the presidential public financing system. This controversy has attracted widespread news coverage and prompted numerous editorials, including in the New York Times, Washington Post, USA Today, Philadelphia Inquirer, and the St. Petersburg Times.

To a large extent, this debate has been fueled by conflicting interpretations of Senator Barack Obama's written response to a question concerning his intention to participate in the presidential public financing system. This question was contained in a questionnaire from the Midwest Democracy Network, which all the presidential candidates were invited to answer in the fall of 2007.
