

LOCAL LEAGUE MENTOR PROGRAM



LWV of Ohio is piloting a mentorship program that offers support and guidance to local Leagues and At-Large Units, focusing on membership growth, outreach, visibility, and leadership development. Our goal is to create a supportive space for League members to nurture each other, fostering a peer-to-peer support system.

Program Scope and Objectives

This six-month program is designed to invigorate and stabilize local Leagues by providing resources for strategic planning and recruitment. During the initial half of the program, the Membership Committee will host two calls between the mentoring League and the League seeking mentorship. Once the relationship between the two Leagues has been established, program facilitation transitions to the mentoring League for continuing support. The program concludes with a call between the mentee, mentoring League, and a Board member from the Membership Committee.

Our structure of ongoing communication ensures a comprehensive and impactful experience for all participants. The feedback provided by both mentees and mentoring Leagues informs customized assistance, targeted to the specific needs of each League.
